

Holy Week Schedule of Events

Holy Thursday-March 29

Service begins at 7 p.m., and will include the Sacrament of Communion.

The Confirmation Class will assist with the service.

Good Friday—March 30
Service begins at 7 p.m.

Easter Saturday and Sunday

We will rejoice in Christ's resurrection at all three services Easter Weekend.

Saturday worship begins at 5 p.m. in Fellowship Hall. Sunday services are at 8 a.m. in Fellowship Hall and 10:15 a.m. in the Sanctuary.

The 10:15 service will feature the Flowering of the Cross during the Children's sermon time, with music from the Chancel Choir, the Grace Chimers, and orchestra.

Flowering of the Cross

This annual tradition transforms the old rugged cross into a living and beautiful symbol of Christ. During the 10:15 a.m. children's sermon, the children of Grace will attach flowers to the cross. Then, as the congregations sings Easter hymns, the cross is raised in the sanctuary as a symbol of Christ's eternal life. It is a powerful moment in the service. All children are encouraged to come forward for the Flowering of the Cross.
