### Fifth Sunday Offering

The Mission Committee voted to designate the Fifth Sunday Offering in April to Hawthorn Hill-New Directions Shelter.

The New Direction Shelter has provided free, temporary, emergency shelter and services for lowa's homeless parents and their children since 1990. The shelter is located at 3001 Grand Avenue in Des Moines, and is a mission project of United Methodist Women. The shelter's director is Tim Shanahan, who is also the director at Bidwell Riverside.

In 2017 the program provided assistance to 119 homeless families, including 304 children, through two programs: New Directions Shelter and The Home Connections. The programs helped 55% of the families to acquire permanent housing, and 80% of the adults to get employment. Seventy-five percent of the families that completed the Home Connection Program transitioned into market-based rental housing, and 25% purchased their own home.
