As Christians, we like to think of this time of the year as a time to think beyond ourselves. Many organizations do worthy work. This season we hope you will consider one or more of the following opportunities, all of which our church supports.

Last Chance to Make a Gift to Heifer International

You still have time to add to what other Grace members have contributed! So far, donations which will help alleviate poverty have been designated for:

- 2 llamas which provide wool and transportation
- 2 flocks of chickens a good hen provides 200 eggs a year—protein for family plus income from selling eggs
- 3 gifts of honeybees which provide honey to sell for income as well as pollinators to help crops
- a Hope Basket with rabbits and chickens—quickly reproducing and going on to another family
- 2 biogas stoves help save the environment by reducing the need for fire wood and by eliminating harmful smoke fumes
- tree seedlings that help renew the soil as well as provide fruit or nuts for food or to sell

PLUS: another \$!,000 has been donated for the "most needed" which can be as varied as helping a girl go to school, providing clear water for a village, or giving a family a goat which offers milk for cheese or yogurt or to give children a source of nutrition. Your gift can help us reach out to others around the world so others less fortunate than we can make their way out of poverty.
