Douglas M. Woods Challenge Hunger Campaign

Since 2013, the Douglas M. Woods Challenge Hunger Campaign has been matching gifts to the Des Moines Religious Council Food Pantry Network, thanks to benefactor and retired West Des Moines police office Doug Woods. The campaign offers \$20,000 in matching funds, and has raised a total of more than \$350,000 for DMARC over the past four years. While in-kind food donations are still very important to DMARC's work, making a cash donation allows DMARC to purchase from two to six times the amount of food any of us could in the grocery store with the same dollar. Cash donations also save man hours because the items purchased don't have to be sorted to eliminate expired items, rusty cans, and partially used items. During the Challenge, a \$10 donation will help to purchase 40 meals. This is a great opportunity for Grace UMC to respond to the overwhelming need in our community and to help those in dealing with food insecurity. The Challenge runs from March 1 through April 30.
